From biotechnologies to artificial intelligence and nanorobots... Which future(s) will we wish for ?

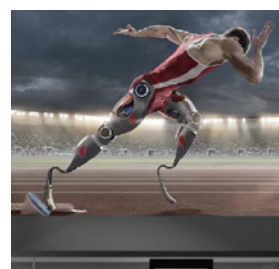
AN ORIGINAL, IMMERSIVE AND FUN EXHIBITION

Repaired, enhanced, hacked, genetically modified... The human being of tomorrow is being designed daily in laboratories across the world. What if you were to become participants in this evolution? With its big new exhibition **#HumainDemain** [HumanOfTomorrow], the Quai des Savoires is giving you the chance, from February 2018 onwards, to slip into the skin of an investor to discover scientific and technical innovations, principally in the fields of body and health. Artificial intelligence, DNA scissors, prostheses... what technology would you like to invest in for tomorrow? Here's your chance to influence research!

Co-produced by the Quai des Savoires and the Muséum de Toulouse, **#HumainDemain** is an immersive and playful exhibition, linked directly to current research. It lets you discover (and test!) new cutting-edge technologies as well as become aware of the ethical questions they raise. In parallel with this exhibition, we have devised a programme rich in encounters, debates, workshops and shows, which forms part of the city's 2018 status as "Toulouse, European City of Science*".

*TOULOUSE, EUROPEAN CITY OF SCIENCE IN 2018

In 2018 for the first time in France, Toulouse will host the Euroscience Open Forum (Esof), the biggest interdisciplinary meeting on science and innovation in Europe. In parallel with the forum for professionals, the Science in the City festival and events throughout 2018 will be held for the general public. As such, Toulouse has been awarded the 'European City of Science' label for 2018.



FIVE SHOWROOMS

Reprogram your DNA, increase your strength with an exoskeleton, experience enhanced hearing... During their tour, the visitor-investor will discover five showrooms, dedicated to five different themes (repair your body, all connected, robots and artificial intelligence, hacking, etc.) which will present today's technical and scientific innovations...some of which are quite amazing!

A CONNECTED BRACELET

Equipped with a connected bracelet, the visitor will be invited to choose a certain number of innovations presented in the showrooms in which they wish to invest for tomorrow's society. The "Top 10" innovations that have aroused the greatest interest among visitors will take shape, one visit after the other. Four animated films then give a humorous take on the different possible futures, according to the innovations voted for!
